


### FOUR KEYS TO SUCCESSFUL LOCAL PROJECTS

4. Funding




#### **Things to Think About**

Situational Awareness – Pay attention to calendar and events


Use partners wisely

#### **Even More Things to Think About**

- Provide honest information to all sides
- Observe lobbying rules and restrictions
- Prepare for disappointment
- No one said this was going to be easy



#### Things to Do

 Schedule local briefings with elected officials and staff at each level of government

Prepare a one pager with key messages, project status, and next steps

Develop a focused request – hone your "ask"

Follow meetings with a thank you



#### More Things to Do

- Put key staff contacts on your notification and mailing lists
- Invite officials and staff to next roundtable or event
- Request letters of support for specific applications
- Big checks, groundbreakings and ribbon cuttings
- Encourage mobile workshops and site tours




#### **Even More Things to Do**
