



Five Criteria for Collective Impact

1) Backbone Organization – independent staff dedicated to the initiative

2)Common Agenda – shared vision
 3)Shared Measurement System – consistent measure of success

4) Mutually Reinforcing Activity – need a plan.
5) Continuous Communication – regular meetings
