Background:

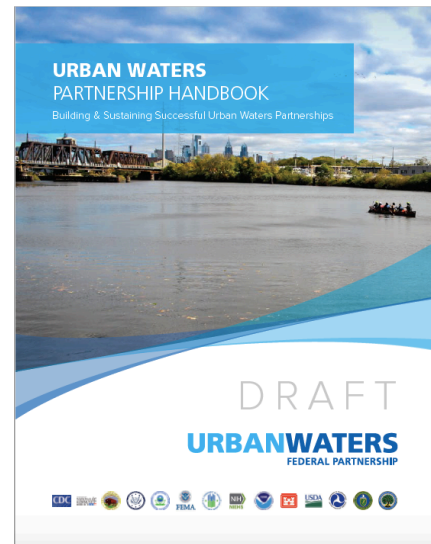
Beginning in 2011, Urban Waters Partnerships were initiated locally and nationally by the Urban Waters Federal Partnership, with 19 locations in place today. Through this work, we have learned from communities about how a partnership model can enhance local urban waters restoration efforts and how the federal family can deliver more integrated support for these community-driven efforts.

Growing Demand:

A growing number of localities have expressed interest in creating their own Partnerships to help realize their visions for clean, safe, accessible urban waters, revitalized communities, and thriving local economies. In response, the Urban Waters Federal Partnership has collaborated with existing partnership locations to develop a handbook that reflects a working approach and learnings based on our collective experiences.
